Limit 2 entries per class per exhibitor, except 1 entry in breed/crossbreed and carcass barrows.

Swine must comply with general & livestock regulations in this Premium Guide.

Registered animals must have original registration certificates available for inspection at the Fair. Commercial animals must have age verification.

Swine must have ear notch identification.

Pen rent (\$5.00 per head) must be paid at time of entry.

Breeds not listed will be shown together as "Other Breeds."

Advance entry required and due August 11, 2009.

Swine must be on the fairgrounds by 6 pm Tuesday.

Check with superintendents for pen assignments before housing animals.

Exhibitors must show their registration certificates or age data to superintendents for entry verification before 8 pm Tuesday.

Exhibitors must keep passageways clear and put manure in available containers.

NO PARKING in livestock area Saturday through Saturday, 8am-

9pm, except to load/unload swine. Vehicles in violation will be

towed at owner expense.

Swine release is Saturday, September 19, 6 pm

No premiums will be paid to an exhibitor who removes any animal from its pen before release time.

4. Limit 1 barrow per exhibitor per class.
5. Weight 230-280 lbs. (gilts not eligible).
