Stall Rent (\$15.00 per Head (must be paid at time of entry). Tack stall \$30.00. Limit 1 tack stall per exhibitor if available. Advanced entry required and due August 11, 2009.

Draft Horses, Draft Mules, Jacks & Jennets arrive by 1:00 p.m. Saturday, September 12, and released 10:00 p.m. Monday, September 14.

**MUST BE OUT OF STALLS BY NOON TUESDAY.**

Mini Mules and Draft Ponies arrive by 6:00 p.m. Wednesday, September 16, and released 6:00 p.m. Saturday, September 19.

**NO STRAW WILL BE USED FOR BEDDING -- SAWDUST WILL BE ON THE GROUNDS.**

Horses may be registered or grade.

Age of horses in this show will be computed from January 1 the year it was foaled.

Check with superintendent for stall assignments before housing livestock.

Exhibitors must show their registration certificates or age data to the superintendent for entry verification on arrival.

Exhibitors must keep passageways clean at all times and put manure in available containers.

**NO PARKING** in livestock area Saturday through Saturday, 8am-9pm, except to load/unload animals. Vehicles in violation will be towed at owner expense.

**No premiums will be paid to an exhibitor who removes any animal from its stall before release time.**
