Birds will be shown in the following classes.

1. Old Cock: All males hatched in 2007 or before.
2. Old Hen: All females hatched in 2007 or before.
3. Young Cock: All males hatched in 2008 only.
4. Young Hen: All females hatched in 2008 only.
Note: All colors (varieties) will show together in their breed, except where specified.

Rules-

1. Limit one entry per class per exhibitor. Total entries subject to limitation due to available space.
2. The same animal cannot be exhibited in both open class and 4-H.
3. All pigeons exhibits must comply with the General Rules & Regulations in this Premium Guide.
4. Birds with split bands or wing bands will be shown as old birds regardless of age.
5. Cage rent/feeding charge is \$1.00 per pigeon, paid with entry.
6. Mail entries on official entry form with fees to: Marilyn Schott, 7379 State Hwy. 72, Jackson, MO 63755. Entries must be received or post-marked by August 11, 2009.
7. Exhibitors must provide 2 containers (for feed & water) per pen and secure them tightly to the cages. Containers must be tall, 8 oz. or larger size (no paper) and proper height for the bird.
8. Birds will only be accepted for exhibit at the Poultry Tent Wednesday, September 16, 10:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m.
9. Cages are pre-assigned by the superintendent. Exhibitors are to enter the grounds at the Livestock Entrance and check in with the superintendent, then house and initially feed and water their birds before leaving.
10. All judging decisions are final.
11. Birds cannot be removed during the Fair, except by order of the Superintendent. Sick animals must be removed immediately.
12. Animals must remain caged until release time, 6 p.m. Saturday, September 19, and removed before 9 p.m. that date. Premiums forfeited on violators.
