1. Show of bloom or blooms at their peak.
2. Foliage.
3. Cleaness of color.
4. Size and form of plant, according to variety.
5. Grooming and care of plant.
6. Cultural perfection.

Cut Flower Classes

Cut flowers will be judged on:

1. Blooms at their peak.
 2. Cleaness of color.
 3. Length and size of stem.
 4. Foliage, including grooming and care.
 5. Size and form, according to variety.
 6. Cultural perfection.
2331. Collection of garden flowers on (1) stem of each (no shrubs)
 2332. Coxcomb Crested, one (1) stem with foliage.
 2333. Coxcomb Plumed three (3) stems with foilage.

2334. Cosmos six (6) stems, one color or mixed colors.
2335. Cleome, three (3) stems, one color or mixed colors.
2336. Dahlia, Large, one (1) stem bloom, over five inches (5").
2337. Dahlia, Medium, three (3) stems bloom, three inches to five inches (3"-5").
2338. Dahlia, Small, three (3) stems bloom, under three inches (-3").
2339. Dahlia Cactus, one (1) stem bloom over five inches.,
2340. Dahlia collection, one (1) each color.
2341. Gladiolus , three (3) stalks, one color or mixed color.
2342. Marigolds, large, one (1) color, six (6) blooms with foliage.
2343. Marigolds, small, one (1) color, six (6) stems with foliage, up to 12 blooms.
2344. Petunia, six (6) stems with foliage, one color or mixed colors, up to 12 blooms.
2345. Rudbeckia, three (3) stems, one (1) color.
2346. Snapdragons, six (6) stems, one color or mixed colors.
2347. Sunflower, small varieties, one (1) stem. with one (1) bloom.
2348. Zinnia, large bloom, over five (5) inches, six (6) blooms, one color or mixed colors.
2349. Zinnia, medium bloom, three to five inches, six (6) blooms, one color or mixed colors.
2350. Zinnia, small bloom, under three inches, six (6) stem, up to twelve (12) blooms, one color or mixed color.
2351. Any other cut flowers not listed above, three (3) stems.
2358. Rose, white, one (1), long stem.
2359. Rose, pink, one (1), long stem.
2360. Rose, red, one (1), long stem.
2361. Rose, yellow, one (1), long stem.
2362. Rose, two-toned, one (1), long stem.
2363. Rose, any color not listed above (1) long stem.
2364. Collection of Roses, one (1) of each color, long stem.
2365. Antique or Heritage Rose, one (1), stem.
2366. Floribunda Rose, one (1), stem.
2367. Knock Out Rose, one (1), stem.
2370. Miniature Rose

Flower Arrangement Classes

A flower arrangement is the use of plant material, living or dried, to create an artistic display.

Arrangement Classes will be judged on:

1. Use of color.
 2. Use of material.
 3. Artistic Effect.
 4. Style-unique.
 5. Style-classical.
 6. Cleaness and cleaness of overall display.

 2376. Dish Garden
 2377. Combination of Foliage and Blooming Plants.
 2378. Cut flowers, artistically arranged.
 2379. Miniature Fresh and/or Dried Plant Material Arrangement, under five inches including vase.
 2380. Arrangement using all dried plant material.
 2381. Theme Arrangement - a display depicting an event or holiday, may include one Non Plant emblem that is part of the theme, ex. Flag, Football, etc.
