CO-OP Service Center, Inc., Jackson, MO. will present a beef herdsmanship award.

Limit 2 entries per class per exhibitor, except 1 entry in carcass steer.

Cattle must comply with general, livestock, and animal health regulations in this Premium Guide.

Registered animals must have original registration certificates available for inspection at the Fair. Commercial animals must have age verification. All cattle must have legible tattoo or brand identification.

Breeds not listed will be shown together as "Other Breeds."

Stall Rent (\$10.00 per head) must be paid at time of entry. Tack stalls same price. Tack stalls limited to one per exhibitor, if available.

Advance entry required and due August 11 2009.

Animals must be on the fairgrounds by 12:00 noon Wednesday

Please DO NOT use straw for bedding. SEMO Fair will have wood bark bedding in beef cattle stalls upon arrival at the cost of \$5 per head entered and will be noted on entry form.

Check with superintendent before tie-in for assigned stall space. Exhibitors must show their registration certificates or age data to superintendent for entry verification upon arrival.

Exhibitors must keep passageways clear and put manure in available containers.

NO PARKING in livestock area Saturday through Saturday, 8 am - 9 pm, except to load/unload animals. Vehicles in violation will be towed at owner expense.

Cattle release is Saturday at 6 pm.

No premium will be paid to an exhibitor who removes any animal from its stall before release time on Saturday or ties out before 7 p.m. on Tuesday through Saturday.

A *Supreme Grand Champion and Reserve Supreme Grand Champion steer of the SEMO District Fair will be selected. The 4-H and FFA Grand and Reserve Champion steers will be eligible to compete for this award.

SEMO Cattlemen Association will award an additional fifty dollars (\$50.00) to the winner of the first place steer carcass if the carcass grades average choice or better.

1. Limit 1 steer per exhibitor. Advance entry required. No stall rent.
2. Steers must be on fairgrounds by 6 pm Tuesday.
3. Steers must be halter-broke to lead.
4. Steers must weigh 1,000-1,350 lbs. and will show together in 1 class. Official weights will be done prior to on-foot judging.
5. Steers showing staginess will be disqualified.
6. Carcass must grade choice or better to be in carcass judging.
7. After on-foot judging, steers will be delivered to Fruitland American Meat, Inc., Jackson, Mo for processing and carcass judging.
8. Carcasses will be purchased by Fruitland American Meat Inc., with payment coming direct from the packer. Carcass payment will be as follows: Choice-yield grade 1 or 2 @ \$9 above yellow sheet; choice-yield grade 3 @ \$5 above yellow sheet; choice-yield grade 4 -5 @ yellow sheet price.
9. Exhibitors are responsible for loss by condemnation or bruise damage.
10. Cut out data will be made available. Premium checks will be mailed.
