2. (A) Senior Gaited Halter  
(B) Senior Western Halter
3. Pony Halter (58" & under)
4. Leadline (Child age 6 & under led by an adult  
18 & over. Ineligible to show in classes 8 or 9)
5. Country Pleasure Racking
6. Plantation Pleasure Lite Shod
7. Ladies Western Pleasure (Ages 19 & over)
8. Youth Gaited Pleasure (Ages 18 & under)
9. Youth Western Pleasure (Ages 18 & under)
10. Ladies Gaited Lite Shod (Ages 19 & over)
11. Junior Western Pleasure (5 years & under)
12. Junior Gaited Pleasure (4 years & under)  
  
**BREAK – Stick Horse Class Fee \$1.00**  
**(Children bring their own stick horse**  
**Ages 8 & under only**
13. Open Performance Gaited  
(Padded- No tail set required -  
Action device permitted)
14. Mule Gaited Pleasure- "Just Plain Fred" challenge  
trophy by Linus F. Huck, DVM Inc. This trophy must be won  
by the same mule/exhibitor combination for 2 consecutive  
years in order to obtain permanent ownership.
15. Ladies Gaited Heavy Shod (Ages 19 & over)
16. Trail Pleasure Racking (tack optional)  
(Not eligible for class 17)
17. Trail Pleasure Walking (tack optional)  
(Not eligible for class 16)
18. Open Western Pleasure
19. Flat Shod Racking
20. Open Country Pleasure Walking (tack optional)
21. Park Pleasure
22. Open Trail (NO OBSTACLES-  
Judged on suitability for TRAIL RIDING ONLY)
23. Youth – Adult Gaited (Youth enter ring and exhibit  
horse first way of the ring. Adults exhibit second  
way of ring. Youth remount for judging.)
24. Open Gaited Heavy Shod Championship  
(Must qualify by placing in top 3 in at least  
one of classes 5, 15 or 21)
25. Open Western Championship  
(Must qualify by placing in the top 3 in at least  
one of classes 7, 9, 11 or 18)
26. Open Lite Shod Championship  
(Must qualify by placing in the top 3 in at least  
one of classes 6, 10, 16, 17 or 20)

## GENERAL RULES AND GUIDELINES

- \*\*\* Gaited classes do not have to canter unless specified.\*\*\*Lite Shod & Trail Pleasure classes require a shoe no greater than 3/8"x 3/4"
- \*\*\*Country Pleasure Walking requires keg shoes only. \*\*\*The use of hoof bands is only allowed on Heavy Shod & Performance horses.
- \*\*\*The use of pads or chains is only allowed on Performance horses \*\*\*No boots.\*\*\* Appropriate attire for Western & English classes.
- \*\*\*Helmets are acceptable in all classes.\*\*\*All gaited horses must be inspected by DQP \*\*\*Exhibitor forfeits entry fees if turned down by DQP
- \*\*\* All 1<sup>st</sup> place gaited horses must immediately return to DQP or forfeit winnings
- \*\*\*To show in a championship class, horse must have shown in a preliminary class.
