Cattle must comply with general, livestock and health regulations in this premium guide.

Dairy animals can be registered or identified by VIP and Identified Grades certificates issued by a national dairy breed association.

Stall Rent (\$10.00 per head) must be paid at time of entry. Tack stalls, same price and limited to one per exhibitor, if available. Advance entry required and due August 11, 2009.

Cattle must be on fairgrounds by 1 pm Saturday, September 12.
