ABGA SANCTIONED SHOW

This show is open to all exhibitors. All animals must be checked in with the superintendent and have health clearance before unloading. **A separate entry form is required for each day of show and write date of show on the form.**

Entries must be made in person or postmarked by midnight, August 12, 2008 to Marilyn Schott, 7379 State Hwy. 72, Jackson, MO 63755. \$15.00/per animal, for stall and entry fees must be paid at entry and is nonrefundable. Entries must be made on the Official Entry Form for Open Division Livestock located at the center of this Premium Guide. The entry form may be reproduced for extra copies. No late entries will be accepted.

Animals may arrive after noon on Friday, September 5, and must be in place by 9:00 AM Saturday, and 7:00 AM on Sunday. All animals must be removed from the grounds by 6:00 AM Monday, September 8.

Goats must comply with general, livestock and animal health regulations in this premium guide. All goats must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection showing the tattoo number of each individual animal.

Goats showing evidence of abscesses or draining abscesses will not be allowed to enter the holding pens or show and may be released by fair officials, veterinarians, State or Federal personnel, or the show health check committee. Goats showing signs of any other disease or neglect may also be released from the show. **HEALTH CHECK COMMITTEE DECISIONS ARE FINAL!**

Any Boer goat showing any pronounced defect or abnormality will be barred from all breeding classes. Animals will be disqualified if there is evidence of artificial coloring; if a doe over 24 months of age that has not kidded, or if the animal was purchased from the event Judge.

The SEMO DISTRICT FAIR or the event organizers will not be held liable for any animals, persons or personal property.

This Show is ABGA sanctioned for Percentage Does, Full Blood/Purebred Does and Full Blood/Purebred Bucks. All Boer Goats must be registered in the herd-book of ABGA, IBGA, USBGA, or CANADIAN BGA before the date of the show.

A registration certificate will be required for all goats six months or older. A registration certificate or stamped, or faxed duplicate application showing the date received by the registry office will be required on all goats under six months of age. The certificates must be checked by the show superintendent or an assistant before the animal can be shown.

Agent letter signed and dated must be presented to Show Secretary and Judge if owner is not present at show.

Animals shown in group classes must also be shown in individual classes. Substitutions are permitted within the same class provided the animal meets the same requirements.

Base date for determining age is the date of the show.

All goats must exhibit well-healed tattoos and tattoos must match registration papers.

A separate entry form is required for each day of show and write date of show on the form.
