2001. Yellow corn, any variety, ten (10) ears.

2002. Yellow corn, any variety, seventy (70) ears.

2003. White corn, any variety, ten (10) ears.

2004. White corn, any variety, seventy (70) ears.

2005. Corn, any hybrid, three (3) stalks.

2006. Broom Corn, three (3) stalks.

Grand Champion, seventy (70) ears - Rosette only.

Grand Champion, ten (10) ears - Rosette only.

Grand Champion, one (1) ear - Rosette only.

SMALL GRAIN

Previous Harvest Season-

All entries shall be in a clear one (1) quart glass jar with lid.

2010. Soft wheat, any variety

2011. Oats, any variety

2012. Winter barley, any variety

SMALL GRAIN - BUNDLES

Entries shall be bound with base diameter of two inches (2") or more.

Classes-

2020. One (1) bundle of sheaf oats, any variety.

2021. One (1) bundle of sheaf wheat, any variety.

2022. One (1) bundle of sheaf barley, any variety.

2023. One (1) bundle of sheaf rice, any variety.

LARGE SEED LEGUMES

All entries shall be in a clear one (1) quart glass jar with lid.

Class-

2025. Soybeans, oil, any variety.

BUNDLE LEGUMES

List variety on entry tag.

Classes-

2030. Three (3) stalks, soybean, oil, early.

2031. Three (3) stalks, soybeans, oil, late.

Grand Champion three (3) stalks soybeans, oil - Rosette only.

2032. Three (3) inch bundle alfalfa.

2033. Bundle of peanuts.

SMALL SEEDED LEGUMES

All entries shall be in a clear one (1) quart glass jar with lid.

Classes-

2035. Lespedeza, any variety.

2036. Red clover.

2037. Sweet clover.

GRAIN, SORGHUM & SWEET SORGHUM

Classes-

2040. Grain sorghum, five (5) heads, late.

2041. Grain sorghum, five (5) heads, early.

2042. Sweet sorghum, five (5) stalks, silage type.

2043. Sweet sorghum, five (5) stalks, molasses type.

GRASSES

All entries shall be in a clear one (1) quart glass jar with lid.

HAY & STRAW

Classes-

2060. Hay, one (1) bale of red clover.

2061. Hay, one (1) bale of fresh alfalfa.

2064. Hay, one (1) bale of mixed grass. (Two or more kinds of grass)

2074. Sunflower, ornamental, one (1) head under 12".

COTTON

2080. Cotton, two (2) stalks any variety and defoliated.
